

Terms and Conditions

AA Visiting School Barcelona 2017 Scholarships

1. Entities, objectives and scope of application

The Visiting School Architectural Association (AA) School of Architecture in London awards 2 scholarships, which cover 100% of the cost of tuition for the AA Visiting School Barcelona 2017, exclusively for students of architecture or design enrolled in a university in Spain, to support and encourage the full involvement of local students, and to guarantee their participation in this course, through their best students. Thus, the academic excellence of the students of the universities of the whole Spanish State is rewarded, as well as, it gives support to his talent and will push them to consolidate his academic or professional career.

2. Amount and payment of scholarships

The AA Visiting School Barcelona 2017 scholarships cover 100% of the tuition fees for the academic year (635 GBP), while the amount corresponding to accommodation and subsistence (500 GBP) and the registration fee to the Architectural Association (60 GBP) will be paid by the awarded student during the registration process, once the scholarship has been obtained, using the forms and electronic means established for this purpose. Any other costs in relation to the participation in the course AA Visiting School Barcelona 2015, as well as all those expenses that can be derived from the participation in this course, will be covered the student.

3. Requirements to be able to submit the application

The only requirement to apply to the AA Visiting School Barcelona 2017 scholarships is to be enrolled, at the time of application, in one of the undergraduate, postgraduate or doctoral courses in architecture or design, belonging to any Spanish university. Persons with first-degree relationship with a member of the management team of the AA Visiting School Barcelona 2017, as well as members of the evaluation committee that will award the scholarships, will not be able to apply.

4. Documentation to be submitted by the applicant and communication

Given the objective of the AA Visiting School Barcelona scholarships, the required documentation is as follows:

1. Letter of motivation, in English (maximum 500 words) that includes the presentation of the academic and professional motivation to participate in the course, as well as the personal and contact details of the applicant.
2. An image in DIN A4 format that best represents the work of the student.
3. Enrollment of the current course, demonstrating that the student is enrolled in any Spanish university.

The documentation will be sent by e-mail to the following address: aavsbarcelona@aaschool.ac.uk, with the title "Application for AAVS Barcelona Scholarships". The files will be in PDF format, each being a separate file, with a maximum weight of 5Mb (between all the files together). The deadline for reception of the applications will end on **Saturday, July 15th of 2017, at 14:00h**. This electronic address will be the only communication channel with the team of AA Visiting School Barcelona.

Students who obtain one of the AA Visiting School Barcelona 2017 scholarships must formalize their electronic enrollment and pay the rest of the corresponding amounts through the form enabled for that purpose in the link "online application" in the "apply" section of the site Web site <http://barcelona.aaschool.ac.uk> (Home> Apply> Online Application). During the pre-registration process, write the observation "AA Visiting School Barcelona 2017 Scholarship" in the box corresponding to additional information.

5. Committee and evaluation procedure

The evaluation committee composed of the members of the organizing team will draw up an evaluation report and inform the applicants individually of their results. This record, which will be signed by the members of the evaluation committee, cannot be revoked. The evaluation criteria will involve the evaluation of the image provided and the professional and academic motivations of the candidates, generating an orderly and valued list of all students, following criteria of strict academic and professional excellence.

6. Conditions and regulations

The presentation of the application for the granting of the AA Visiting School Barcelona 2017 grants implies the full knowledge and acceptance of this terms and conditions by the candidate who is applying for the scholarship. The evaluation committee reserves the right to modify or extend the present terms and conditions, without prior notice.

Given the goal of excellence and promotion of the talent pursued by the AA Visiting School Barcelona 2017 Scholarships, the awarded students are committed to attend the entire AA Visiting School Barcelona 2017 course, and demonstrate that they are worthy of this opportunity. Otherwise, and unless justified by force majeure, they must pay the cost of the course for which they have been awarded.

In case of cancellation of the course AA Visiting School Barcelona 2017 by force majeure, the scholarships AA Visiting School Barcelona 2017 will be invalidated.

The AA Visiting School Barcelona 2017 scholarships are not cumulative with other offers, agreements or discounts that may have been agreed with the different universities, companies or entities.
